2019-20 International Student Checklist

At Griffin School, we are thrilled to be able to accept international students and provide I-20 visas to enable students to study in this country. Our academic program is well designed to support international students who are seeking a supportive school environment that will provide solid preparation for university study in the United States.

To facilitate the application process, international students must submit the following documents. This information is needed to evaluate student readiness for enrollment at Griffin School and for processing of a visa application. Therefore, all documents below must be submitted before admissions can be granted and an I-20 issued.

Application checklist:

- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of Passport
- Guardianship Documentation
- Parent Application
(must contain both local Guardian information and Biological Parent Info)
- Student Application
- English/math assessment
(ISEE, IELTS, TOEFL Jr.)
- Current Transcript
- Immunization Records
- Copy of Bank Statement
- Skype interview
- \$75 application fee

Upon acceptance to the Griffin School, and once families sign an enrollment contract and pay the school's Annual Fee, the I-20 will be issued. The Annual Fee is non-refundable, but any tuition paid in advance will be refunded if the student is denied a visa.
